# **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**



Dear Friends of the Foundation,

2018-2019 was a year of great transformation. We had completed the previous year with the goal of creating a strong, committed and collaborative Foundation to be a significant player in the cause of helping the elderly in our community. With all the changes in the last year and the recent launch of our new funding, we are finally in a position to move forward confidently with our mission and vision.

During the last year, the Foundation team upgraded the four main pillars of the Foundation's organization and functioning: communication, finances, governance, and administration. All four required our attention so we could reach our objectives.

#### Communication

Our communications strategy and tools had to be reviewed to reflect our new purpose. The objective was to be able to better spread our **love and care** message, highlight our mission and allow a better awareness of the Grace Dart Foundation.

This led us to the creation of a new website, which will be our platform to collect donations and distribute funds. We also installed a more efficient database to track donations, online payments, manage receipts and create reports. Finally, we hired Exponentiel Conseil, a public relations firm, to make sure we have solid footing in the world of communications and social media.

#### Finances

The first objective was to know exactly where we are and determine how we could use our assets to maximize our impact, while ensuring a prosperous future for our organization. The answer to this question came naturally, since we now wanted to bring **love and care** to as many elderly as possible in CHSLDs, as well as supporting non-profit organizations that provide in-home care to the elderly in the greater Montreal area. The second objective going forward will be to develop our fundraising plan. Since the Foundation's creation in 1973, there has been little, if any, fundraising activity. This essential dimension of a foundation now has a new raison d'être and will be an important development tool for us in the future.

#### Governance

Recent modifications have been made to the governance of our organization in the last 15 years. With many changes in the healthcare system, we were due for a large household cleaning. We partnered with two specialists in non-profit governance, Karine Chênevert from Borden Ladner Gervais and Lisane Dostie from Isalegal, to examine our needs and make the necessary updates.

#### Administration

To bolster our operations, we hired an assistant, Catherine Guérin, so we could grow at a great speed. On the accounting side, we also hired Nicole Dugas of Gestias to ensure an impeccable and efficient service. We are also looking forward to have new offices adapted to our growth. We can be proud of our organization's journey this year. We have definitely taken huge steps in creating an adequate, relevant, strong and involved foundation. We are now ready to become an important player, deeply involved in the cause of the elderly, and in a perfect position to spread **love and care** to the elderly of Greater Montreal.
